If the anchor rod is too short, the anchor rod may be projecting below the foundation. If the rod projection is too long, the embedment may not be adequate to develop the required tensile strength.* Too Low

Anchor Bolts Too Low or High - Portland Bolt of the anchor rod is set in a position that is either too short or too tall to allow for the nut to be tight and at least flush with the point/top end of the anchor rod. Note that when an anchor rod is too tall, the rod's embedded length should be verified since the extra length above the concrete may have come from the rod being set too shallow. One option for an anchor rod that is set too tall is to stack

Anchor bolt issues: bolts too low or too far, need ... 1. Not fully expanding a drop-in anchor because the wrong setting tool was used or the operator simply "felt" that the anchor was set. 2. Setting a stud anchor at too shallow a depth because it was on top of a rebar. 3. Setting a capsule anchor by simply driving the threaded stud into the capsule and not spinning it.

10 wood framing errors and how to avoid them ... The anchor won't function properly unless this is done, even though it might feel strong when it's screwed in. The wings are pulled firmly against the wall after the screw is installed. Plastic anchors should be installed carefully to prevent them from being damaged. They can hold between 25 and 35 pounds each when used in drywall.

The Different Types of Hollow Wall and Drywall Anchors Drill a hole using the recommended drill bit size (the width of the toggle ends) Slip the bolt through the hole of what you're hanging (i.e. a bracket) then thread on the toggle with the tips facing the screw head. Squeeze the toggle closed and tap the bolt, toggle and all, into the wall.
