Chords are built in 3rds from the major scale. So a Major chord is built by stacking the notes of the major scale in 3rds (C Major = C E G B D F A). Since we run out of notes if we only stack within one octave, we use a two octave scale. This is why you will see numbers associated with some chords over 7 (there are 7 notes in the scale).

CHORD PROGRESSIONS Table 42 summarizes the only four harmonic interval (chord progression) types: • Seconds (up or down), • Thirds (up or down), • Fifths (up or down), • Chromatic (exiting or returning).
