Rule of thumb: divide the pixel size (dimension) of the image by the resolution (at least 300 ppi) to get the maximum print size in inches. So, if your image is 2,000 pixels in length at 300 ppi, then you can print it up to six inches or so (2,000 divided by 300).

What size is a high resolution photo? Hi-res images are at least 300 pixels per inch (ppi). This resolution makes for good print quality, and is pretty much a requirement for anything that you want hard copies of, especially to represent your brand or other important printed materials.

If you were to print a photo using a web-sized file you could print a 6 x 4 photo but anything larger will usually lose detail and clarity. In simple terms, high resolution photos are best for printing and enlarging, and web-sized photos are best for computer use (website, social media, email, digital documents).

Multiply the printed image ' s width and height in inches by 300 pixels. The result is 2,400 x 3,000 pixels, which is the image resolution you need to print an 8 x 10 image at 300 PPI. Therefore, when cropping and sizing an image for printing, you ' ll need to know what PPI the image should be.

Because images need to be printed at 300 ppi, there ' s a quick and easy way to determine the maximum size that an image can be printed at: simply divide the number of pixels in the image by 300. Here ' s an example: The image below is 600 by 300 pixels. 600 by 300 divided by 300 = 2 by 1, so the largest size this image can be printed at is 2 by 1 .

A high-resolution image is anything that has at is 300 dpi high resolution with a larger pixel dimension, for example, 5000 x 4000 pixels. If you have an image that is 640 x 40 at 72dpi, you definitely have too small of an image!

One of the biggest requests I get from my clients is to see if their art is the right size for print or multi-media. Without getting too technical, " lo-res " is considered 72 dpi and is best for web, and " high-res " is 300 dpi for print. A lot of the photos from small non-profits are event shots.
