In InDesign, choose File > Print. Click Graphics. In the Fonts section, choose None from the Download menu. If the document prints, the printing problem may be related to one of the fonts used in the document. If the document uses a large number of fonts, excluding the fonts makes the document less complex.

Troubleshoot printing problems in InDesign

I almost never directly print, but Export to PDF exclusively. And if you use that instead, you can choose any of the standard presets -- High Quality, Press Quality, etc. -- no printer dependent settings. The print options inside InDesign and Acrobat are (partly) optional, depending on the printer driver you happen to have installed.
