They are renewed every 5 years, and the next set of guidelines will be released in late 2020. Red Cross CPR Steps. 1. Push hard, push fast. Place your hands, one on top of the other, in the middle of the chest. Use your body weight to help you administer compressions that are at least 2 inches deep and delivered at a rate of at least 100 compressions per minute. 2.

The new CPR guidelines (2010) are meant to encourage untrained bystanders to help a person who collapses, and to avoid being paralyzed into not assisting by the fear of doing something wrong. Ideally, the sequence is pretty easy. The victim collapses from a heart attack or other heart problem and is unresponsive and isn't breathing.

The American Heart Association announced its newest CPR recommendations on October 16 th, 2015. The new CPR guidelines are based on the latest scientific data from the previous 5 years. The new update has placed limits on how fast and deep chest compressions should be performed. The guidelines are updated every five years.

How to perform CPR: Guidelines, procedure, and ratio

The 2015 guidelines still recommend traditional CPR cycles of 30 chest compressions to two rescue breaths for one-rescuer CPR in all age groups and for two-rescuer CPR in adults. The 15:2 ratio of compressions to breaths remains in the 2015 guidelines for two-rescuer CPR for children and infants.
